Overview

The formal definition of evidence-based medicine (EBM) is "the conscientious, explicit and judicious use of current best evidence in making decisions about the care of individual patients."¹

Evidence-based medicine integrates clinical expertise, patients' values and preferences, and the best available evidence from the medical literature.²

Content development

Resources are identified for the development team by the Research Director, our clinicians, and our subject matter experts.

Unacceptable Sources

- Broad based Google searches
- Content from commercial and for-profit organizations; such as MAYO Clinic, Cleveland Clinic, Intellihealth
- Patient education created by commercial producers
- Private research (i.e. not vetted/published by a recognized organization)
